## Renovated El Chorro Lodge opens

The **El Chorro Lodge** has reopened with a new menu that still includes some favorites from its recent past.

Principal Jacquie Dorrance and operating partners Tim and Kristy Moore bought the Paradise Valley property last year from longtime owners Joe and Evie Miller for an undisclosed amount. Dorrance is the wife

of Bennett Dorrance, managing director of Phoenix real estate company DMB Associates and a major shareholder in the Campbell Soup Co., which his family founded more than 100 years ago.

Over the past few months, crews have renovated the property creating an indoor-outdoor bar, upgrading finishings and expanding the restaurant.

The facility now offers Wi-Fi and has a new sound system. It also has added a lawn area for events and an event space called Casa Paloma, which can host parties of 300.

The new menu features El Chorro's famous sticky buns, as well as lobster tail, rack of lamb, duck, and entrees and appetizers that reflect the Southwest, Sonoran and continental cuisines.
